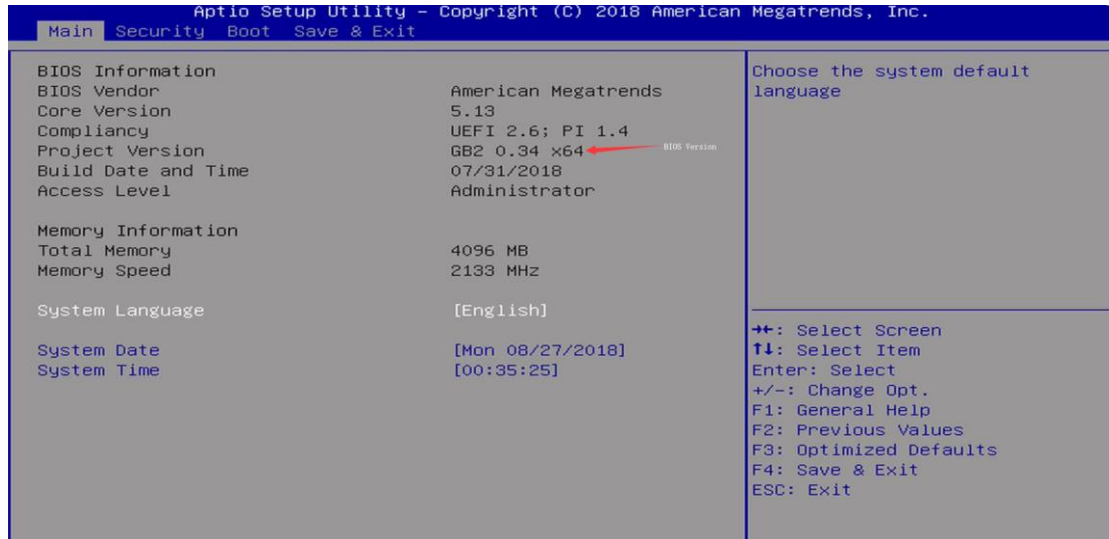
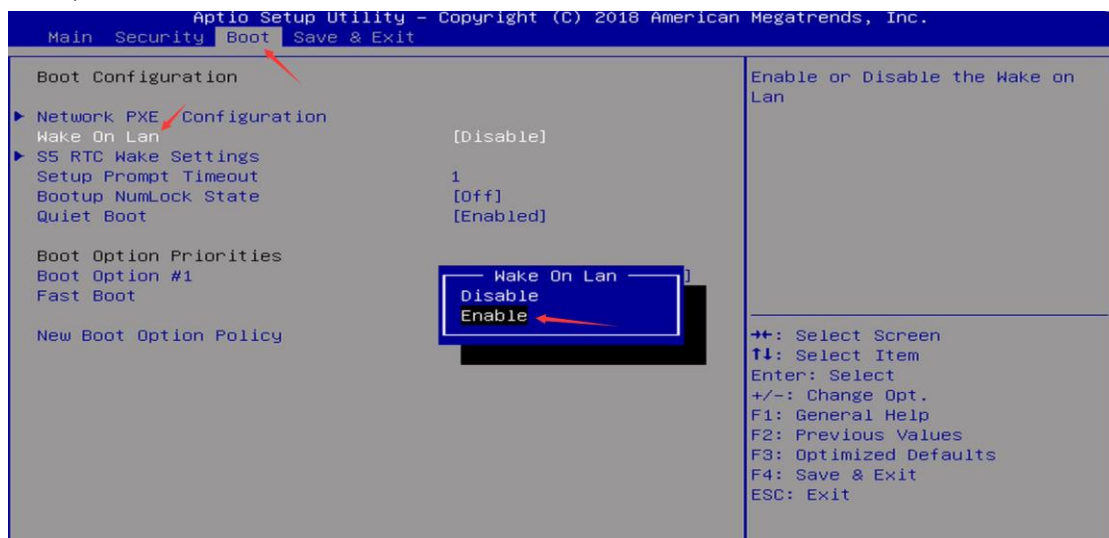


How to enter the BIOS to set the network wake-up function

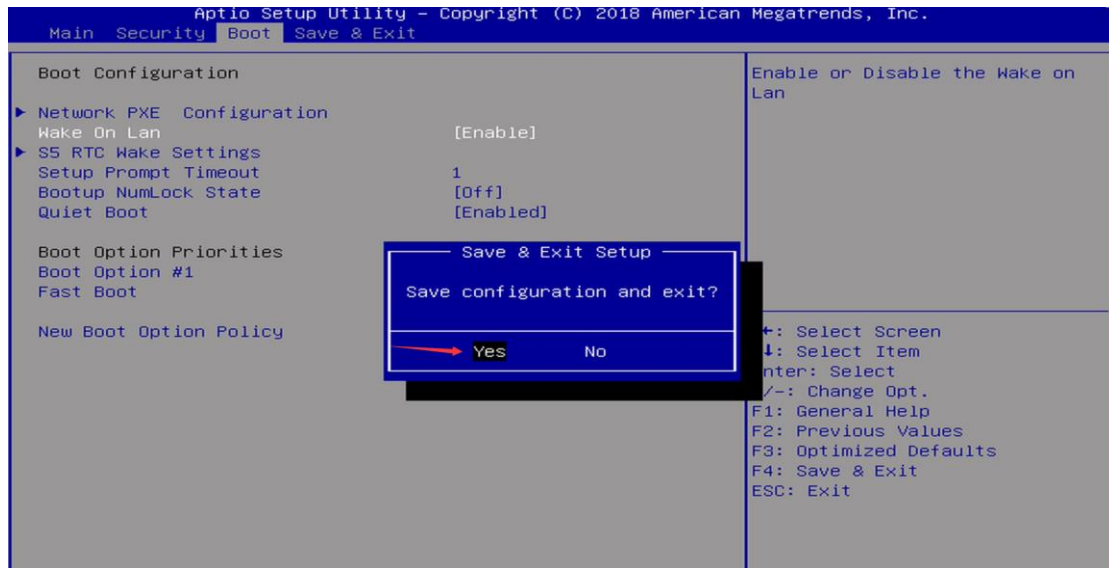
1. Press and hold the keyboard delete to enter the BIOS.



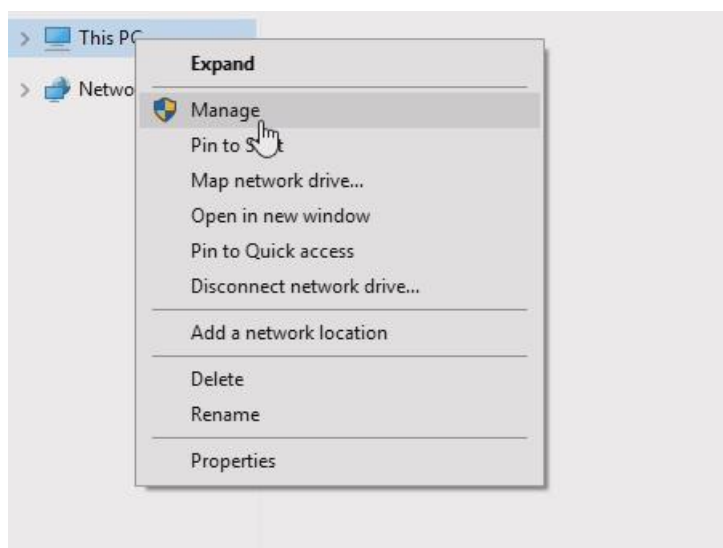
2. Use the keyboard arrow keys to find Boot, select Wake on lan, Enter to enter, pop up options, select Enable



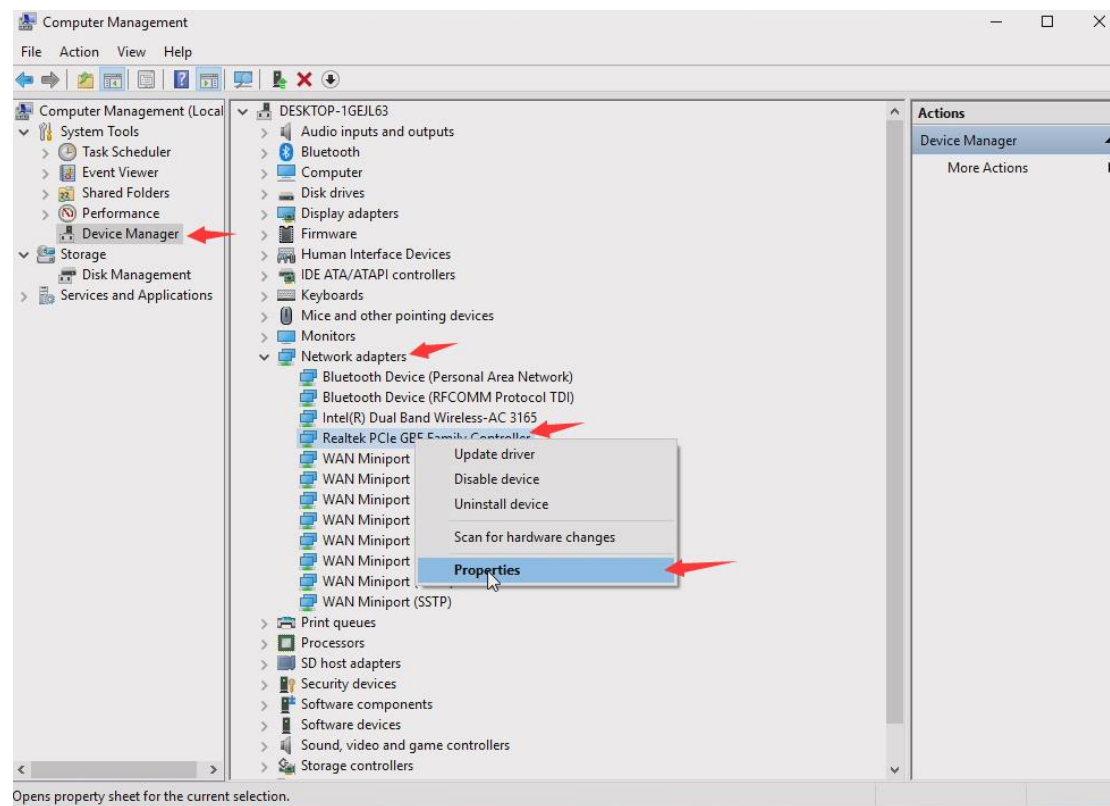
3. Press Enter, press F4 to select Yes to save the settings and exit, automatically reboot into the system.
