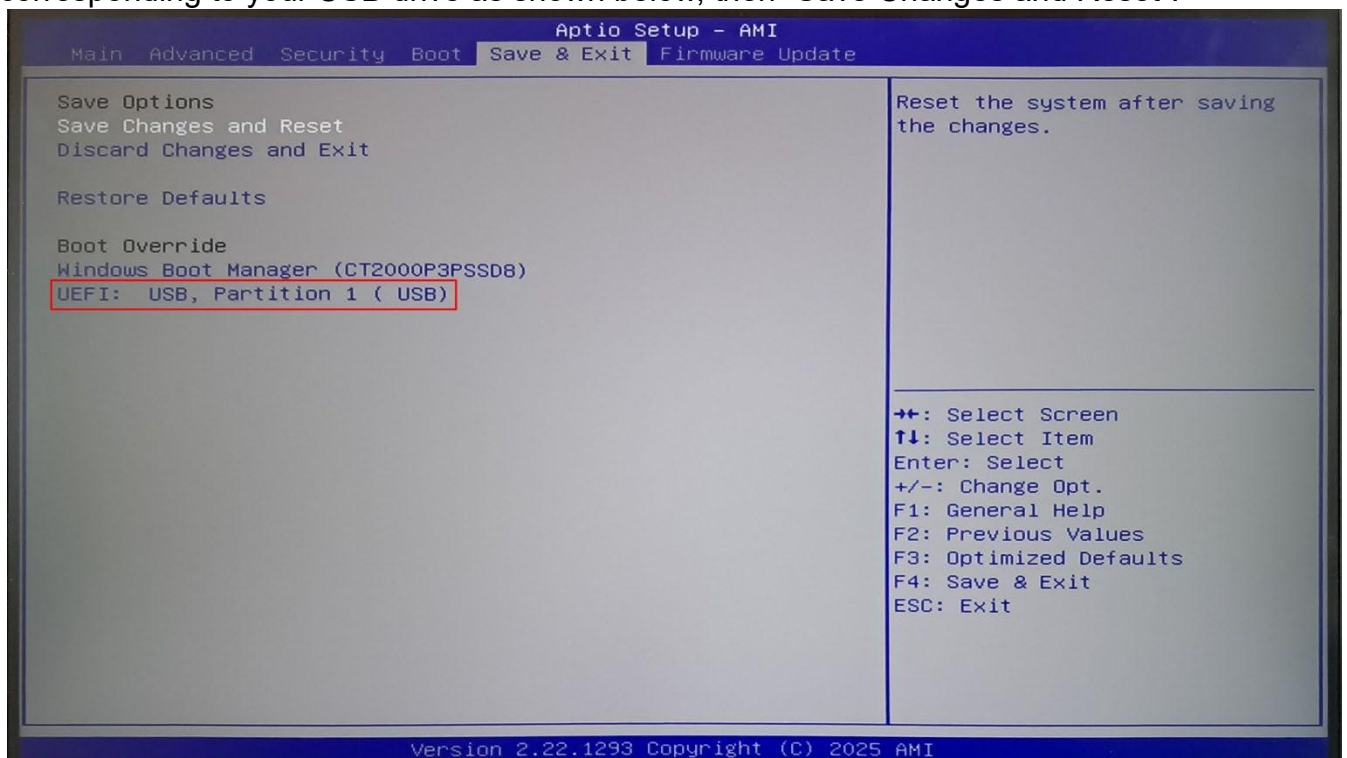


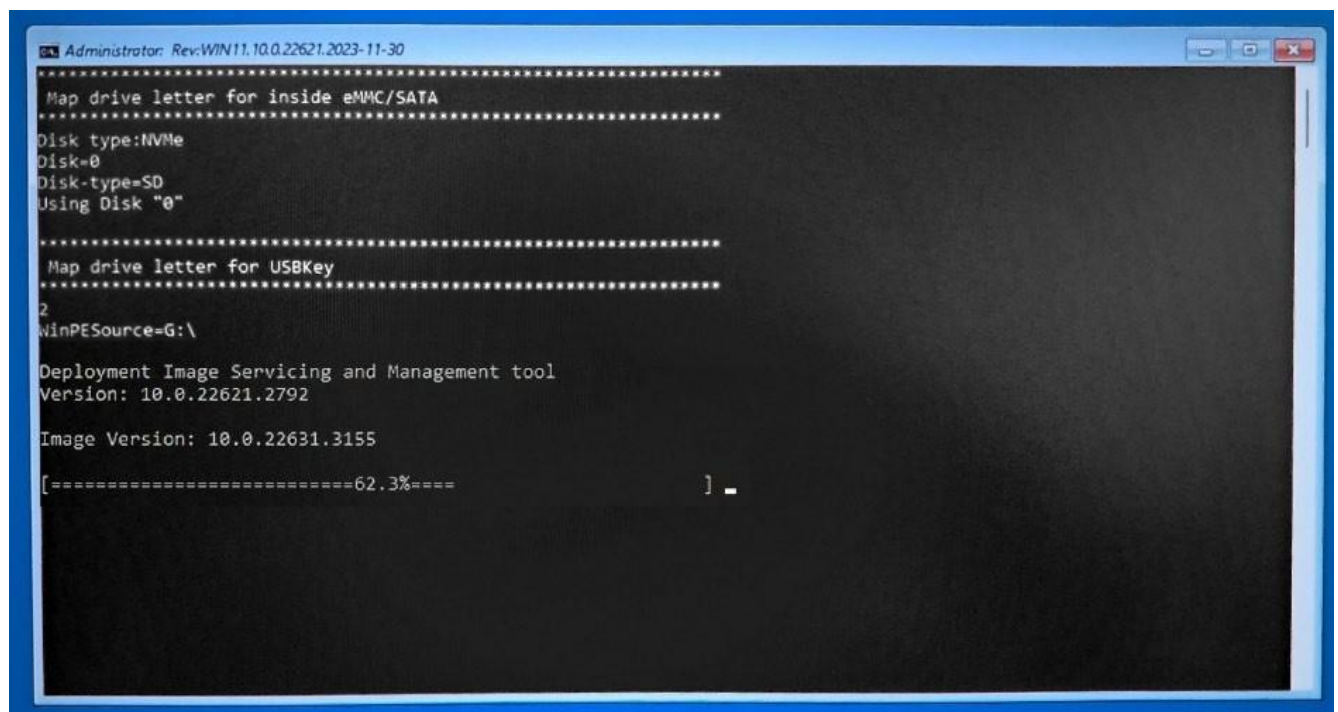
Clean Install of Windows 11

To cleanly reinstall Windows 11, follow all the steps below.

1. Before you begin, download and save the following files to an external device:
 - The Windows11 23H2_10language.zip file available on the site <https://gofile.io/d/GU0mPV>.
 - The driver file for your computer is available on the website <https://gofile.io/d/lppfGO>.
2. Backup all your data from your computer to an external device.
3. Format a 16GB USB drive to NTFS.
4. Name the USB drive "WINPE".
5. Unzip the Windows11_23H2_10language.zip file into a folder.
6. Copy the contents of the folder to the root of the USB drive.
7. Restart your computer.
8. Press the "Delete" button repeatedly to enter the BIOS.
9. In the "Save and Exit" menu, under the "Boot Override" section, select "UEFI: USB, ..." corresponding to your USB drive as shown below, then "Save Changes and Reset":



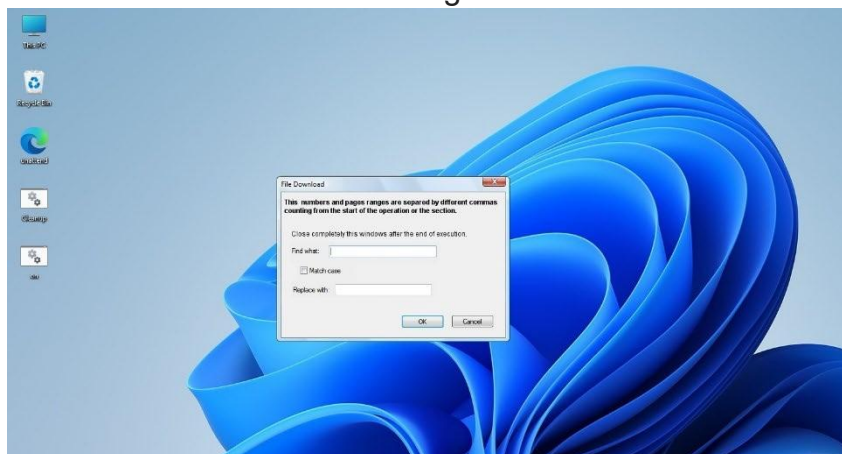
10. When your computer restarts, you will see a command prompt similar to the one below:



11. Start your computer and Windows 11 will complete its installation.

12. Once the installation is complete, your Windows desktop will appear.

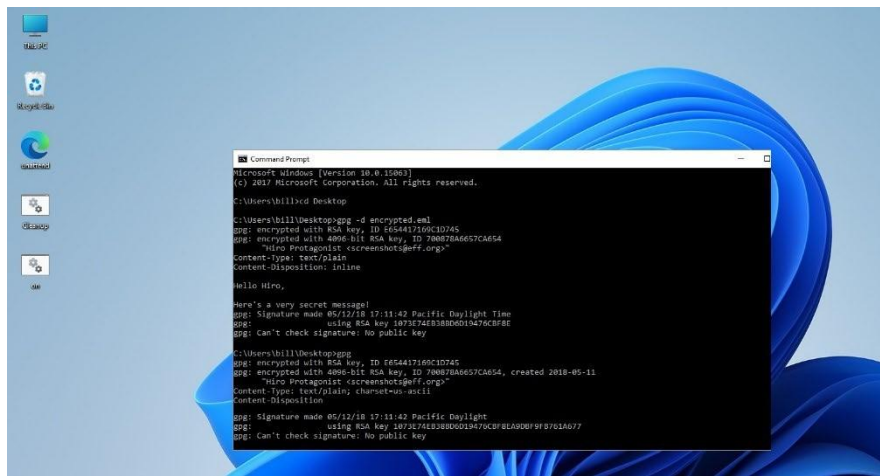
13. Please close the interface dialog box as shown below:



14. Double-click the Windows command script file "Cleanup" as shown below to perform the system reset and skip the steps to register school and work accounts :



15. When the cleaner program starts, a command prompt window appears, as shown below:



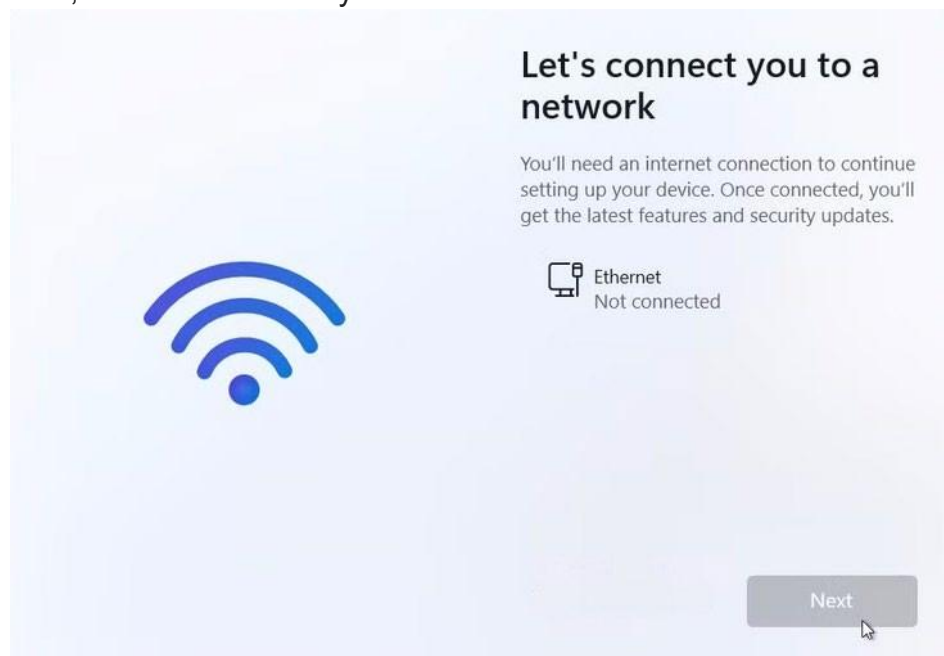
16. After 5 minutes of waiting, the computer will automatically shut down.

17. Restart your computer and Windows will configure your computer.

18. The first setup screens will ask you to choose your language and keyboard.

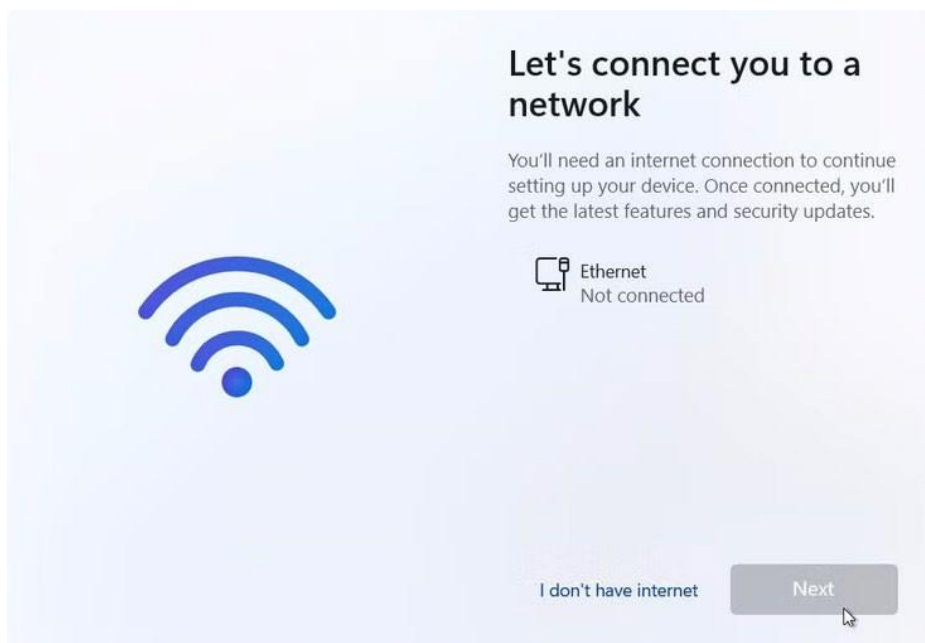
19. The computer will restart.

20. Next, Windows will ask you to connect to the Internet:



21.If you are unable to connect to the internet, follow these instructions:

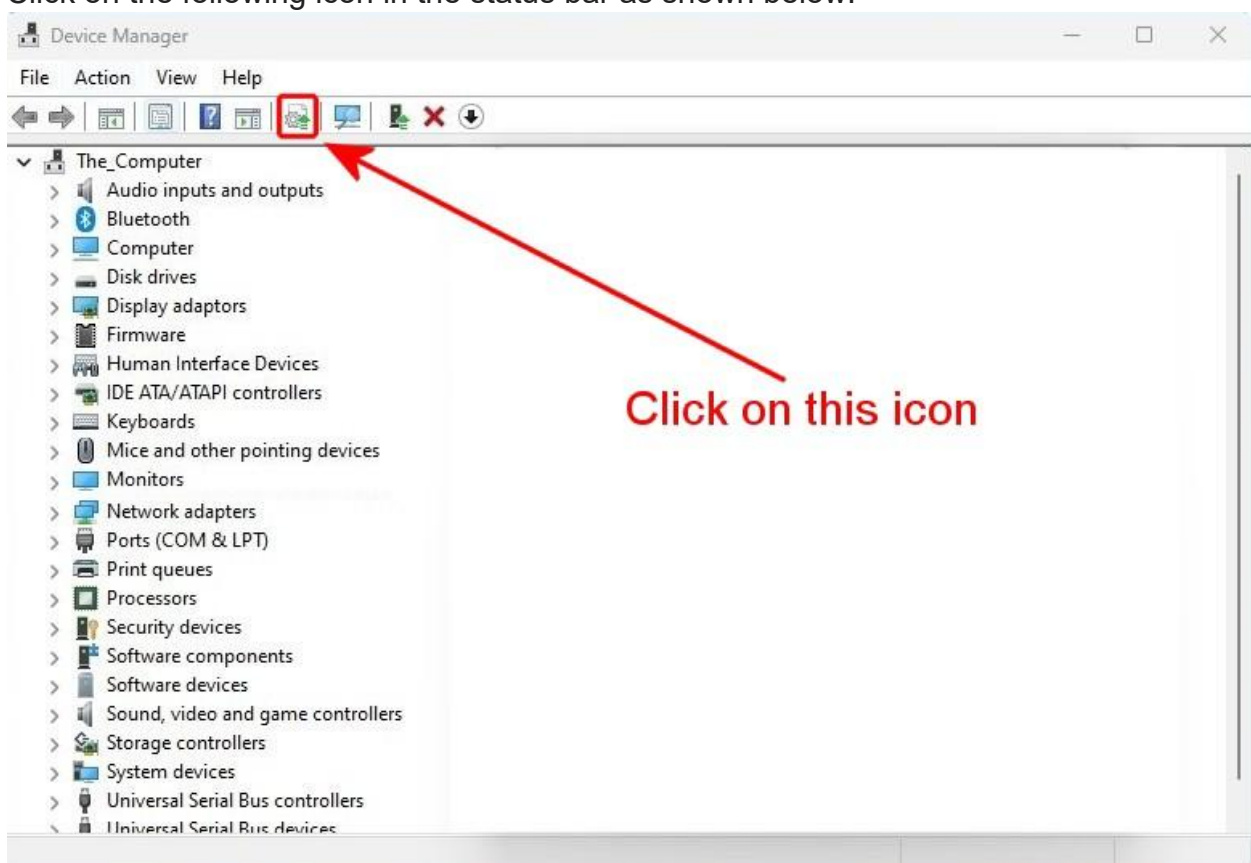
- Press Shift + F10.
- A command prompt window will appear.
- Run the following command: "oobe \bypassnro".
- Your computer will restart and the Windows 11 installer will launch again. You can click the "I don't have internet" button, as shown below:



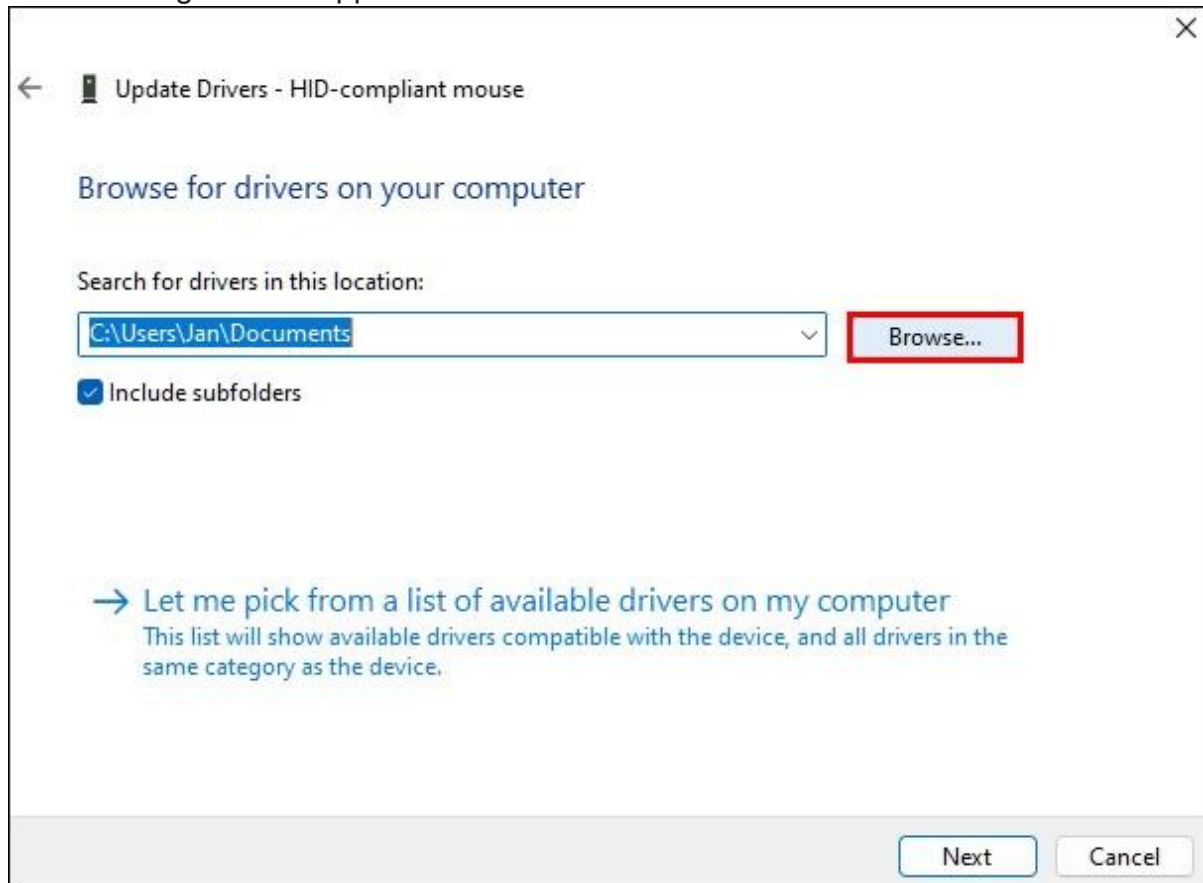
22. Complete the Windows 11 setup.

23. To complete the installation, you need to update the drivers. Follow these steps:

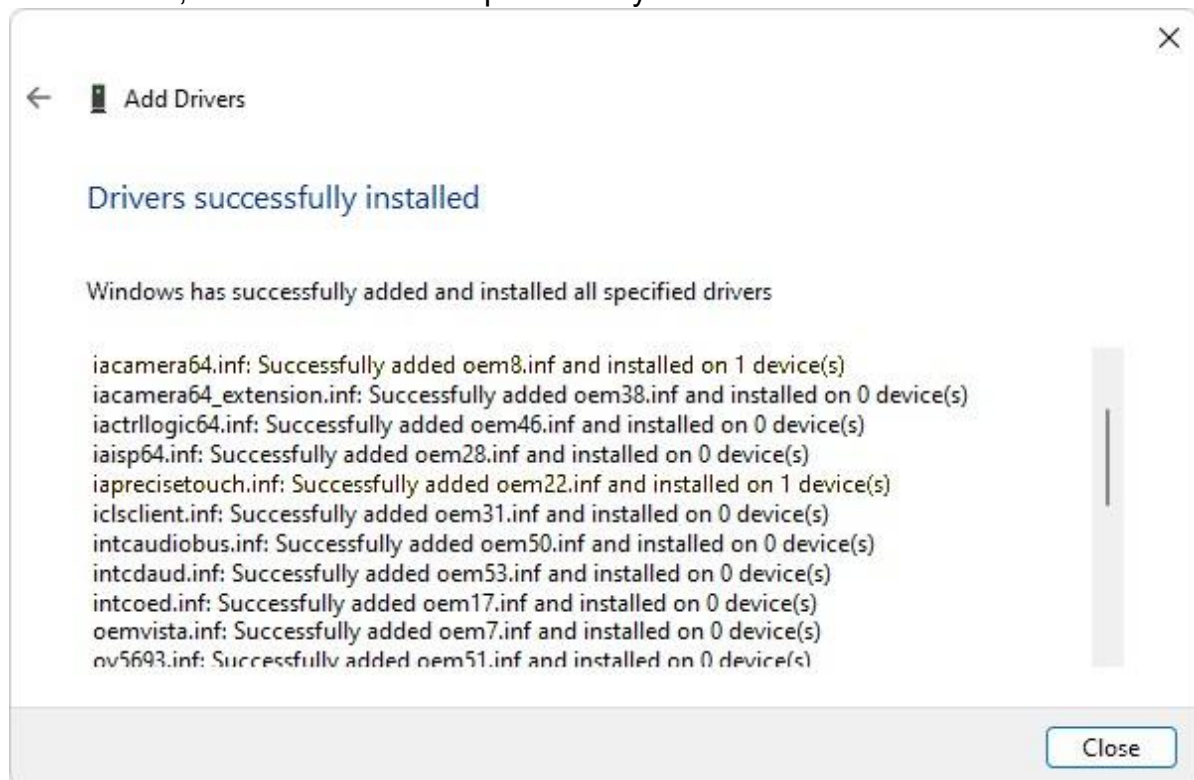
- Unzip the driver files (as indicated at the beginning of the procedure) into a folder.
- Open "Device Manager".
- Click on the following icon in the status bar as shown below:



- The following window appears:



- Choose the folder where you unzipped the driver files.
- Click on the "Next" button.
- After a while, Windows will have updated all your drivers as shown below:



24. Restart the computer.

That's it, Windows 11 is successfully installed!
